Wine making

Hand-harvested in 15kg boxes. Thorough selection of grapes followed by soft destemming. Classic red vinification, fermentation-extraction lasted 7 days at temperatures between 25-32°C. The wine was aged in new and 2-year-old oak barrels for 18 months. (25% American oak, 75% French oak)

Tasting Note

Deep ruby-red colour. Clean, aromatic and high-toned nose of dark berries, red cherries, spice, pepper and a hint of apricot and lavender. Balanced and savoury palate of blackberry fruit and cherry oak with lovely mouthfeel, good structure and an incredibly long finish. A seductive wine with lots of potential.

Food matches

Serve this wine with juicy steaks, slowsmoked ribs, or with Parmigiano veal. Serve at 16-17°C.
