

## Mountain Fish 2015

Dry red wine - Protected Geographical Indication Peloponnese

### MOUNTAIN FISH



**Variety:** Agiorgitiko

**Region:** Vineyards in the mountain region of Nemea, in the villages Asprokambos and Psari. The grapes are planted in deep, clayey, alkaline soils and yields never exceed 9000 Kg/Ha. The area's climate characterized by cold winter and high amounts of snow and rain, while summer is dry, with hot days and cool nights.

**Harvest:** End of September

**Vinification:** Destemming and crushing into stainless steel tanks are followed by maceration and fermentation that last for approximately 2 weeks, while the temperature never exceeds 26°C.

**Characteristics:** Vivid red colour. The varietal aromas of Agiorgitiko such as small red fruits dominate nose, whereas the palate is refreshing and smooth, with velvet tannins and long aftertaste.

**Serving Suggestions:** Excellent aperitif wine. It goes well with a huge variety of meats and dishes from Greek cuisine. As a serving suggestion it is recommended to try it slightly chilled.
