Dry Red Wine -Protected Geographical Indication Peloponnese

Varieties: Agiorgitiko80%, Cabernet Sauvignon20%

Region: Vineyards in the mountain region of Nemea, planted in

Stymfaliaplateau, located at 700m of altitude, in deep, clayey, alkaline soils, with moderate yield (less than

9.000 kg/ha).

The area's climate is characterized by cold winter and high amounts of snow and rain, while summer is dry,

with hot days and cool nights.

Harvest: Mid-September.

Suggestions:

Vinification: After careful selection of the grapes, destemming and

crushing is carried out, followed by fermentation and maceration at 25° C.The young wine matures for 12

months in 300 ltFrench oak barrels.

Characteristics: A deep red colour, aromas of ripe cherries and red

berries, vanilla and dark chocolate, a rich taste, with good

structure and long after-taste.

Serving Grilledred meat, game, red spicy sauces, cheese and

charcuterie dishes.
