## Dry Rosé Wine - Protected Geographical Indication Peloponnese

- Varieties:** Agiorgitiko 100%
- Region:** Vineyards in Northern Peloponnese, at Asprokampos village, in Stymfalia plateau, located at 700m of altitude, in deep, clayey, alkaline soils, with moderate yield (less than 9.000 kg/ha). The area's climate is characterized by cold winter and high amounts of snow and rain, while summer is dry, with hot days and cool nights.
- Harvest:** Middle of September.
- Vinification:** Grape crushing and a 3 hour maceration are followed by pressing and alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel tanks at 15° C, with a selected strain of saccharomyces.
- Characteristics:** Pale rosé color, aromas of red fruits like strawberry and cherry, with a hint of butter caramel. Distinguished by its fresh rich flavor with a pleasant acidity, balanced taste and long fruity aftertaste.
- Serving Suggestions:** A pleasant rosé that compliments ideally snacks, light dishes of the Mediterranean or international cuisine, while harmoniously pairs with salads and fruits. It can also be served as aperitif.
