## Strofilia Estate Oditis

Dry Rosé Wine - Protected Geographical Indication  
Peloponnese

- Varieties:** Agiorgitiko 100%
- Region:** Vineyards in Northern Peloponnese, at Asprokampos village, in Stymfalia plateau, located at 700m of altitude, in deep, clayey, alkaline soils, with moderate yield (less than 9.000 kg/ha).  
The area's climate is characterized by cold winter and high amounts of snow and rain, while summer is dry, with hot days and cool nights.
- Harvest:** Middle of September.
- Vinification:** Grape crushing and a 3 hour maceration are followed by pressing and alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel tanks at 15° C, with a selected strain of saccharomyces.
- Characteristics** Exceptionally bright and a light colour between light rosy and salmon. Intense and fresh on the nose with aromas of watermelon, strawberry, white flowers, such as violet and rose petals, coupled with lemon13 citrus, grapefruit and a hint of minerality.
- Serving Suggestions:** Excellent with salmon, grilled grouper, pastourma pie, grilled shrimp, while being the ideal accompaniment for light dishes of Mediterranean cuisine, sushi. Goes very well with fruit salads. Also drunk as an aperitif.
